These changes, effective after Fall Break, come as a result of feedback from parents and having one full school year behind us. Now seems like a good time to introduce these new options and reinforce our current dress code.

Lately, we have been seeing <u>MANY</u> variations and interpretations to our current dress code. To clarify our dress code, I have created a document with sample photos of clothing items that meet our uniform policy. In order to maintain the intent of our dress code and to communicate infractions more effectively, we will begin sending a note home with children whose clothing is not compliant with the uniform policy. Children that repeatedly are not in school uniform will be sent to the office to call a parent/guardian to bring appropriate clothing to school. Further infractions may result in disciplinary action.
